### **TRS TRUSTEE LIVIA M. KISER RESIGNS**

SPRINGFIELD, IL – Teachers' Retirement System Trustee Livia M. Kiser has resigned from the TRS Board of Trustees, Executive Director Dick Ingram announced today.

In a letter to Ingram dated April 2, 2011, Kiser said that the responsibilities of her private law practice conflicted with the time TRS business “deserved and requires.”

“It is with deep regret that I have concluded that it simply will not be possible for me to continue to serve as a trustee given my professional responsibilities,” Kiser said.

Kiser, of Downers Grove, was appointed to the 13-member TRS Board by Governor Pat Quinn in June of 2009. Her term was set to expire in 2014. Kiser's seat on the board is one of six trustees appointed by the governor. No timetable has been established for naming a replacement.
